

Physics (Paper-II)

The JEE (Advanced)-2015 Paper-II is much easier than Paper-I and all questions were straightforward, involving less calculations. But there has been two key features. Firstly, the passage based questions had multiple correct answers with negative marking. Secondly, no single correct type question has been asked. Also, Modern Physics and Optics reappeared making the distribution amongst various topics skewed. It is expected that students would do well in this paper.

Chemistry (Paper-II)

Chemistry question Paper-II for JEE (Advanced)-2015 was overall a tricky moderate paper. Some of the questions required critical and analytical thinking. An average student can score 35-40% of the marks. The paper was equally balanced among physical, organic and inorganic Chemistry. This paper consists Inorganic Chemistry with logical questions, Physical Chemistry was majority from 12th class and Organic Chemistry was easy. Overall, it is scoring paper relative to Paper-I.

Mathematics (Paper-II)

In this section mostly questions were tricky. The paper has 3 sections comprising of Integer based, multiple choice question and comprehension based problems. According to Aakash experts paper was lengthy and students were unable to complete the paper. This paper was well balanced with difficulty level as well as topics level.
